The week of September 19th-24th, Monterey Peninsula Foundation will host the 2017 PURE Insurance Championship impacting The First Tee. We are contacting you to ask if you would be a part of this special event by hosting a junior golfer and a chaperone.

This year marks the 14th anniversary of this PGA TOUR Champions tournament which showcases The First Tee. This tournament is unique, pairing amateurs with top junior players and PGA TOUR Champions legends, with proceeds benefitting The First Tee programs. The 81 juniors who are chosen to participate come from every part of the country, diverse socio-economic backgrounds, and each is extremely enthusiastic and honored to compete in the event.

Juniors and chaperones will arrive Tuesday, September 19th and will depart Monday, September 25th. The juniors will be accompanied by a chaperone, who will be responsible for the junior during the week. As a host, you will not be required to provide transportation or meals. All juniors are provided breakfast and lunch Tuesday through Sunday and dinner is provided to them at evening events on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. If the junior is available for a meal, the host family is welcome to include the junior in their meal plans. The goal of a housing host is to enhance this experience by creating a comfortable and inviting environment for the juniors during this busy week.

If you are able to assist, please either complete the attached Host Housing Information Form and return it to the Monterey Peninsula Foundation by August 10th or complete the registration online by using the link provided to begin the application process.

In appreciation of your support, once you are approved, you are invited to the annual Champions Dinner on Wednesday, September 20th, at The Lodge at Pebble Beach. In addition, all housing hosts will receive two (2) tickets to the 2017 PURE Insurance Championship and two (2) tickets to the 2018 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Over the years, wonderful relationships have been established between the juniors and their housing hosts, creating a more personal and rewarding experience.
