Each junior will be accompanied by a chaperone, who will be responsible for the junior during the week. All juniors are provided breakfast and lunch Tuesday through Sunday and dinner Tuesday through Friday. If the junior is available for a meal, the host family is welcome to include the junior in their meal plans, but there is no requirement.

Juniors and chaperones will arrive Monday, September 23rd and will depart either Sunday, September 29th or Monday, September 30th.

In early September, The First Tee will use the information you provide and match you to your junior and their chaperone. Once the match is made, they will send you detailed information about your guests.
